1. Notes of Previous Meeting The action points arising from the previous meeting were discussed.

JP confirmed that the variation to condition 31 is partially discharged and that the remainder will be an ongoing condition with further monitoring necessary as site progresses. TU confirmed.

MW reminded the panel of a suggestion for a viewable feed from further monitoring for public access, although there is no requirement under current planning for this to be in place. To be considered at next round of monitoring – likely early 2022.

AM questioned the need for the above suggestion when considering the lack of any complaints regards noise.

JH discussed the likelihood of a variation to the current permit to match the current planning in terms of annual allowed tonnage for infill.
