1.0 INTRODUCTION

Council to consider the report for two new items of playground equipment and safe surfacing to be supplied and installed at QE2 pavilion. One item to replace end of life equipment and one item to enhance the playground usability for younger children and parents. Costs to be met from EMR 333, Capital Works Play Areas.

2.0 WORK REQUIRED

To supply and install two new items of playground equipment and safe surfacing to develop the area as identified for younger children including a parent and child swing and a multi seat roundabout.

3.0 QUOTES RECEIVED

Quotes are attached containing costs for supply and install and a combination of supply only and install only, hoping to obtain best value.

4.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

To accept the combination of Quotes C and D.

This recommendation is based upon the equipment suitability for this area, being double dipped galvanised framework providing better protection to the salt air and reducing maintenance regarding annual painting and providing a parts supply for a minimum of 20yrs after end of production.

Accepting this combination, I believe obtains best value practice and delivers a worthy project to the community.
