### **Review of the Local List of Heritage Assets**

Proposed inclusion of the following assets:

- Lepe WW2 Remains
- WW1 Eaglehurst Camp, RNAS Calshot
  - St Georges Hall, Tristan Lane, Calshot
  - Nos 1 – 3 Castle Lane - WW1 Military Huts
- Cold War Lepe Royal Observer Corps Post

Further to our recent letter, I am writing to advise you that heritage assets located in your parish above, were approved to be added to New Forest National Park Local List of Heritage Assets by the Authority's Planning Committee on 20 December 2022. We are writing to all owners to advise them of this.

An asset which is included on the Local List is not nationally listed but is recognised locally as being of historic interest and making a positive contribution to the character of the area. Should you or a future owner wish to make alterations or carry out works which require planning permission, these factors will be given more consideration than something not on the Local List.

Inclusion on the local list does not however prevent appropriate extensions, alterations or other changes, or even demolition in the future, subject to an assessment against the relevant local and national planning policies in place at
